ISCA has become a very strong sport for all network in the last years. Thanks to its active participation in different Forums and debates, the voice of the sport for all organisations has been included in the agenda of the sport institutions and other sectors events.

ISCA's policy, focus on the idea to identify the sport for all activities and programs as a cross sector tool; has been considered an attractive topic for another sectors, like health, education, social integration, economic development...

Thanks to the development of different projects, professionally lead by its staff, ISCA has been placed as a competent partner for Public Institutions like European Commission, National Ministries and local public institutions, being active part in events and media.
