TRAVEL TO TRIESTE

All flights must land at the Airport Trieste – Friuli Venezia Giulia www.aeroporto.fvg.it

From the Airport to Trieste Railway Station

There is a coach service: Coach 51. One way price is 4.05 € Tickets can be purchased at the airport:

- from the 24-hour automatic ticket machines, located inside the arrival gate (next to the main exit door) and outside the airport (on the covered walkway, in front of the bus stops)
- at the tourist information counter Infopoint Turismo FVG (arrival gate)

From Trieste Railway Station to Hotel Capitelli – Residence Sara –Hotel Barbacan

Bus n. 24 – Get off at the bus stop in Via Madonna del Mare or Via San Michele.

Bus tickets can be purchased at the Tobacconists' in the Railway Station. One way fare is $1.50 \in$

Taxi to Trieste city centre will be around 10 €.
